ASLG 100 - Elementary American Sign Language Credits 4

Basic principles and practice in the fundamental skills of signs and fingerspelling from the ASL perspective for communication with the deaf. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Grade Mode:** A.

Restriction(s): Must be Undergraduate Level.

ASLG 200 - Elementary American Sign Language II Credits 4

Basic principles and practice in the fundamental skills of signs and fingerspelling from the ASL perspective for communication with the deaf. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Grade Mode:** A.

Prerequisite(s): ASLG 100 or HUFA 101 or equivalent; students with high school American Sign Language should consult with the department for placement.

ASLG 201 - Intermediate American Sign Language Credits 4

Designed for those who possess the basic skills of manual communication. Further instruction in the development of ASL vocabulary, fingerspelling, fluency, receptive and expressive skills. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Grade Mode:** A.

Prerequisite(s): ASLG 200 or HUFA 102.

Restriction(s): Must be Undergraduate Level.
