

# GERMAN (GRMN)

## Courses

### GRMN 100 - German Language and Culture I Credits 4

This is an introductory course designed to build basic language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) by focusing on the cultural content, vocabulary and grammar necessary to develop inter-cultural communicative competence at an intermediate low proficiency level.

**Lecture/Lab Hours:** Five hours each week. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Note(s):** Students desiring to enroll in German should do so during the freshman and sophomore years; it is impossible to complete Core Curriculum requirements (Bachelor of Arts degree) if the student starts in the senior year. **Grade Mode:** A.

**Prerequisite(s):** Students with high school German should consult with the department for placement.

**Restriction(s):** Must be Undergraduate Level.

**Course Fee:** \$40.

### GRMN 100A - German Language and Culture 1A Credits 2

This is the first half of an introductory course designed to build basic language skills (listening, speaking, reading, and writing) by focusing on the cultural content, vocabulary, and grammar necessary to develop inter-cultural communicative competence at an intermediate low proficiency level. **Lecture/Lab Hours:** Five hours each week. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Note(s):** Students enrolled in GRMN 100A must enroll in GRMN 100B in the session that immediately follows; students desiring to enroll in German should do so during the freshman and sophomore years; it is impossible to complete Core Curriculum Foreign Language requirements (Bachelor of Arts degree) if the student starts in the senior year. **Grade Mode:** A.

**Prerequisite(s):** Students with high school German should consult with the department for placement.

**Restriction(s):** Must be Undergraduate Level.

**Course Fee:** \$20.

### GRMN 100B - German Language and Culture 1B Credits 2

This is the second half of an introductory course designed to build basic language skills (listening, speaking, reading, and writing) by focusing on the cultural content, vocabulary, and grammar necessary to develop inter-cultural communicative competence at an intermediate low proficiency level. **Lecture/Lab Hours:** Five hours each week. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language.

**Note(s):** Students enrolled in GRMN 100A must enroll in GRMN 100B in the session that immediately follows; students desiring to enroll in German should do so during the freshman and sophomore years; it is impossible to complete Core Curriculum Foreign Language requirements (Bachelor of Arts degree) if the student starts in the senior year. **Grade Mode:** A.

**Prerequisite(s):** GRMN 100A.

**Restriction(s):** Must be Undergraduate Level.

**Course Fee:** \$20.

### GRMN 200 - German Language and Culture II Credits 4

This is an introductory course designed to build basic language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) by focusing on the cultural content, vocabulary and grammar necessary to develop inter-cultural communicative competence at an intermediate low-mid proficiency level. **Lecture/Lab Hours:** Five hours each week. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Note(s):** Students desiring to enroll in German should do so during the freshman and sophomore years; it is impossible to complete Core Curriculum requirements (Bachelor of Arts degree) if the student starts in the senior year. **Grade Mode:** A.

**Prerequisite(s):** GRMN 100 or HUF 101; students with high school German should consult with the department for placement.

**Restriction(s):** Must be Undergraduate Level.

**Course Fee:** \$40.

### GRMN 200A - German Language and Culture IIA Credits 2

This is the first half of an introductory course designed to build basic language skills (listening, speaking, reading, and writing) by focusing on the cultural content, vocabulary, and grammar necessary to develop inter-cultural communicative competence at an intermediate low-mid proficiency level. **Lecture/Lab Hours:** Five hours each week. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Note(s):** Students enrolled in GRMN 200A must enroll in GRMN 200B in the session that immediately follows; students desiring to enroll in German should do so during the freshman and sophomore years; it is impossible to complete Core Curriculum Foreign Language requirements (Bachelor of Arts degree) if the student starts in the senior year. **Grade Mode:** A.

Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Note(s):** Students desiring to enroll in German should do so during the freshman and sophomore years; it is impossible to complete Core Curriculum requirements (Bachelor of Arts degree) if the student starts in the senior year. **Grade Mode:** A.

**Prerequisite(s):** GRMN 200 or HUF 102; students with high school German should consult with the department for placement.

**Restriction(s):** Must be Undergraduate Level.

**Course Fee:** \$40.

**GRMN 201A - German Language and Culture IIIA Credits 2**

This is the first half of an intermediate course designed to further develop basic language skills (listening, speaking, reading, and writing) by focusing on the cultural content, vocabulary, and grammar necessary to develop inter-cultural communicative competence at an intermediate mid-high proficiency. **Lecture/Lab Hours:** Five hours each week. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Note(s):** Students enrolled in GRMN 201A must enroll in GRMN 201B in the session that immediately follows; students desiring to enroll in German should do so during the freshman and sophomore years; it is impossible to complete Core Curriculum Foreign Language requirements (Bachelor of Arts degree) if the student starts in the senior year. **Grade Mode:** A.

**Prerequisite(s):** GRMN 200B or equivalent; students with high school German should consult with the department for placement.

**Restriction(s):** Must be Undergraduate Level.

**Course Fee:** \$20.

**GRMN 201B - German Language and Culture IIIB Credits 2**

This is the second half of an intermediate course designed to further develop basic language skills (listening, speaking, reading, and writing) by focusing on the cultural content, vocabulary, and grammar necessary to develop inter-cultural communicative competence at an intermediate mid-high proficiency. **Lecture/Lab Hours:** Five hours each week. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Note(s):** Students enrolled in GRMN 201A must enroll in GRMN 201B in the session that immediately follows; students desiring to enroll in German should do so during the freshman and sophomore years; it is impossible to complete Core Curriculum Foreign Language requirements (Bachelor of Arts degree) if the student starts in the senior year. **Grade Mode:** A.

**Prerequisite(s):** GRMN 201A or equivalent; students with high school German should consult with the department for placement.

**Restriction(s):** Must be Undergraduate Level.

**Course Fee:** \$20.

**GRMN 205 - Intercultural Communication in German Credits 4**

This is an introductory course designed to build basic language skills (listening, speaking, reading, and writing) by focusing on the cultural content, vocabulary and grammar necessary to develop intercultural communicative competence at an intermediate low-mid proficiency level. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Note(s):** Offered off campus and includes a service component and course fee depending on the location and itinerary of the class and service component. **Grade Mode:** A.

**Prerequisite(s):** GRMN 100 or demonstration of proficiency through department assessment.

**Restriction(s):** Must be Undergraduate Level.

**Additional Fee(s):** May involve trip fee.
