RUSS 100 - Russian Language and Culture I **Credits 4**

This is an introductory course designed to build basic language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) by focusing on the cultural content, vocabulary and grammar necessary to develop inter-cultural communicative competence at an intermediate low proficiency level.

Lecture/Lab Hours: Five hours each week. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Note(s):** Students desiring to enroll in Russian should do so during the freshman and sophomore years; it is impossible to complete Core Curriculum requirements (Bachelor of Arts degree) if the student starts in the senior year. **Grade Mode:** A.

Prerequisite(s): Students with high school Russian should consult with the department for placement.

Restriction(s): Must be Undergraduate Level.

Course Fee: \$10.

RUSS 200 - Russian Language and Culture II **Credits 4**

This is an introductory course designed to build basic language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) by focusing on the cultural content, vocabulary and grammar necessary to develop inter-cultural communicative competence at an intermediate low-mid proficiency level.

Lecture/Lab Hours: Five hours each week. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Note(s):** Students desiring to enroll in Russian should do so during the freshman and sophomore years; it is impossible to complete Core Curriculum requirements (Bachelor of Arts degree) if the student starts in the senior year. **Grade Mode:** A.

Prerequisite(s): RUSS 100 or HUF 101; students with high school Russian should consult with the department for placement.

Restriction(s): Must be Undergraduate Level.

Course Fee: \$10.

RUSS 201 - Russian Language and Culture III **Credits 4**

This is an intermediate course designed to further develop basic language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) by focusing on the cultural content, vocabulary and grammar necessary to develop inter-cultural communicative competence at an intermediate mid-high proficiency level.

Lecture/Lab Hours: Five hours each week. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Note(s):** Students desiring to enroll in Russian should do so during the freshman and sophomore years; it is impossible to complete Core Curriculum requirements (Bachelor of Arts degree) if the student starts in the senior year. **Grade Mode:** A.

Prerequisite(s): RUSS 200 or HUF 102; students with high school Russian should consult with the department for placement.

Restriction(s): Must be Undergraduate Level.

Course Fee: \$10.

RUSS 205 - Intercultural Communication in Russian **Credits 4**

This is an introductory course designed to build basic language skills (listening, speaking, reading, and writing) by focusing on the cultural content, vocabulary and grammar necessary to develop intercultural communicative competence at an intermediate low-mid proficiency level. Core Curriculum: Approved for Core - Foreign Language. **Note(s):** Offered off campus and includes a service component and course fee depending on the location and itinerary of the class and service component. **Grade Mode:** A.

Prerequisite(s): RUSS 100 or demonstration of proficiency through department assessment.

Restriction(s): Must be Undergraduate Level.

Additional Fee(s): May involve trip fee.
