

# CHRISTIAN MINISTRY AND LEADERSHIP, M.A.C.M.L. (MINISTRY AND LEADERSHIP) - SPANISH / MINISTERIO Y LIDERAZGO CRISTIANO (MINISTERIO Y LIDERAZGO)

## Overview

### Descripción del Programa

La especialización en Ministerio y Liderazgo (<https://www.biola.edu/degrees/g/ministerio-y-liderazgo-cristiano-macml/>) está diseñada con mucha flexibilidad para que los estudiantes puedan tomar cursos electivos que sean más pertinentes a su contexto ministerial actual o futuro (por ejemplo, ministerio de niños, ministerio de jóvenes, grupos pequeños, liderazgo paraeclesialístico, administración de empresas, etc.).

### Degree Program

The Ministry and Leadership specialization is designed with built-in flexibility so students can take elective courses that are most relevant to their current or future ministry context (e.g., family ministry, youth ministry, small groups, parachurch leadership, business administration, etc.).

## Learning Outcomes

### Resultados de Aprendizaje del Programa

Al finalizar la especialización de la Maestría en Artes en Ministerio y Liderazgo, los estudiantes podrán:

1. Demostrar destrezas pertinentes a la formación espiritual personal, lo que incluye una comprensión de la teología espiritual, el conocimiento de Dios y de sí mismo, las habilidades relacionales y la comprensión de su vocación (RAU 1, 2, 3).
2. Explicar las doctrinas principales del cristianismo, incluyendo su fundamento bíblico y su pertinencia contemporánea (RAU 1).
3. Sintetizar los conocimientos, las destrezas y las perspectivas de los contenidos específicos de la especialización del programa de Ministerio y Liderazgo Cristiano para determinar las implicaciones para la práctica profesional (RAU 2).

### Program Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the Master of Arts in Ministry and Leadership specialization, students will be able to:

1. Demonstrate abilities relevant to personal spiritual formation, including an understanding of spiritual theology, knowledge of God and self, relational skills, and an understanding of their vocation (ULO 3).
2. Explain the major doctrines of Christianity, including their biblical basis, and contemporary relevance (ULO 1).
3. Synthesize knowledge, skills, and perspectives from specialization-specific content of the Christian Ministry and Leadership program to determine implications for professional practice (ULO 2).

## Admission Requirements

### Requisitos de Ingreso

Los solicitantes deben poseer una licenciatura o el equivalente académico de una universidad acreditada, con un promedio mínimo de 3.0 (en una escala de 4.0). Los solicitantes que no posean una licenciatura en artes o su equivalente académico de una institución acreditada aún pueden solicitar admisión y pueden ser admitidos provisionalmente a discreción de la Escuela de Teología Talbot. Adicionalmente, los solicitantes deben haber completado un curso acreditado en el estudio del Antiguo Testamento y en el estudio del Nuevo Testamento antes de matricularse. Para cumplir este requisito previo, los estudiantes deben haber obtenido una calificación igual o superior a C en cursos de estudio aprobados de grado o posgrado de una institución acreditada regionalmente. Si los cursos de requisito previo no se completan antes de matricularse, el estudiante deberá tomar TEBE 519 y TEBE 520 durante su programa de estudio.

Todos los solicitantes deben presentar una declaración escrita en la que describen sus objetivos profesionales y la relación de este título con dichos objetivos.

### Admission Requirements

Applicants must possess a Bachelor of Arts degree or its academic equivalent from an accredited college with a minimum grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale). Applicants who do not possess a Bachelor of Arts degree or its academic equivalent from an accredited institution may still apply and may be provisionally admitted at the discretion of Talbot School of Theology. Additionally, applicants should have completed an accredited course in Old Testament survey and in New Testament survey prior to matriculation. To meet the prerequisite, students must have received a C or higher in approved undergraduate or graduate survey courses from a regionally accredited institution. If the prerequisite courses are not completed prior to matriculation, the student is required to take TTBE 519 and TEBE 520 during their program.

All applicants must submit a written statement outlining their vocational objectives and how the degree might relate to those objectives.

## Graduation Requirements

### Requisitos de Graduación

1. Completar satisfactoriamente 49 créditos como se indica en los requisitos del plan de estudios a continuación.

- Los estudiantes que no hayan cursado previamente un estudio del Antiguo Testamento y del Nuevo Testamento deberán tomar TEBE 519 y TEBE 520, además del plan de estudios estándar.
- Completar en línea la introducción a la investigación y la redacción teológica antes de finalizar el segundo semestre.
- Por lo menos 25 de los créditos totales que se requieren para el programa de grado deben ser completados en Biola. Los créditos de Avance Académico, Reducción y transferencia no se consideran créditos de residencia.
- Obtener un promedio de 3.0 con ninguna calificación menor de C- en todos los cursos de crédito que serán computados para la graduación.
- Completar el programa en su totalidad en un máximo de cinco años.
- Consultar con un Consejero de Graduación en la Oficina del Registrador un año antes de su graduación para declarar la intención de graduarse. ## Graduation Requirements

- Satisfactorily complete 49 semester credits as outlined in the curriculum chart below.
- Students without previous courses in Old Testament Survey and New Testament Survey must take TEBE 519 and TEBE 520, in addition to the standard curriculum.
- Complete the online introduction to theological research and writing by the end of the second semester.
- At least 25 of the total credits required for the degree program must be completed in residency at Biola. Advanced Standing and transfer credit are not considered residency credits.
- Obtain a 3.0 average with no grade below a C- in all courses to be credited toward graduation.
- Complete the entire program in no more than five years.
- Meet with a graduate academic records and degree specialist in the Office of the Registrar one year prior to graduation to declare intent to graduate. ## Program Requirements

### Estructura del Programa
